ABOUT THE COLLECTION SYSTEM:

The Collection System is owned, operated, and maintained by the Town of Gibsonville. It consists of approximately 54.3 miles of Gravity Sewer Lines, 0.44 miles of Forced Mains (pressure sewer lines) and 3 Sewage Pump Stations. Each day the town transports an average of 417,000 gallons of untreated wastewater to the South Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant, and an average of 292,000 gallons of untreated wastewater to the East Burlington Wastewater Treatment Plant for final treatment.

SYSTEM PERFORMANCE:

The Town of Gibsonville's personnel work very hard to ensure that our Collection System is maintained and operated at a high standard. Gibsonville is pleased to say that there were no reportable spills in the 2023 calendar year.
